#### ACADEMIC POSITION - DIVISION OF CRITICAL CARE

The Department of Medicine, Division of Critical Care, Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry, at The University of Western Ontario, and its affiliated hospitals are seeking an Intensivist for a full-time clinical academic appointment to The University of Western Ontario. Applicants should be certified, or eligible for certification in Adult Critical Care Medicine, by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, or equivalent. Candidates must have an MD or equivalent, and must be eligible for licensure in the province of Ontario.

The Division of Critical Care is located on two sites - Victoria and University Hospital. This position would be based at the Victoria Hospital site but would also have the opportunity to work in the 14 bed Cardiac Surgery Recovery Unit at University Hospital. Victoria Hospital is a Lead Trauma Hospital for Southwestern Ontario. Clinical responsibilities will include overseeing patient care on all admissions for the 26 bed Critical Care Trauma Centre. There will also be an opportunity to work with the Critical Care Outreach Team.

Applicants for this position will have a commitment to, and demonstrated aptitude for, clinical research. The successful candidate will be expected to teach at the Undergraduate and Graduate level, and supervise Graduate trainees. The candidate will also be expected to take a full role in the clinical activities carried out by the Critical Care Program.

The University of Western Ontario is situated in picturesque London, Ontario, a city of approximately 340,000 along the banks of the Thames River. The City of London is a vibrant community with many family-friendly amenities and has one of the lowest cost of living rates in Ontario.
