



Staff Intensivist

Quinte Health Care Corporation (QHC) seeks a Staff Intensivist for a full service Critical Care Program. This service provides coverage for a newly constructed level III intensive care unit located at QHC Belleville General.

Program: This is a closed management model staffed by a team of qualified physicians, including a Lead Intensivist. Physician coverage will be one week at a time during days, with some night-time on-call responsibilities.

The program is supported by an experienced critical care team including critical care nursing, 24/7 RT coverage, PT, OT, speech therapy, nutritionist and pharmacist.

Support is also provided by consultants in a wide variety of medical and surgical specialties including anaesthesia, cardiology, gastroenterology, internal medicine, oncology, general surgery, orthopedics, urology, gynecology and psychiatry. Full imaging modalities are available including MRI, multi-slice CT scanner, ultrasound, nuclear medicine and PACS.

The QHC Critical Care unit will operate in close conjunction with our tertiary partners at Queen's University. There will be opportunities for Faculty appointment, resident supervision and comprehensive CME via Queen's University.

Remuneration: Remuneration and relocation expenses are nationally competitive.

Qualifications: Successful applicants will be graduates of a Royal College certified fellowship program in Critical Care. Experience with closed management model of delivery would be an asset. Excellent communication and team skills are essential.

Facilities: Quinte Health Care is a multi-site hospital that provides primary and secondary services to a diverse catchment area of approximately 150,000 people in Hastings and Prince Edward Counties and the southeast portion of Northumberland County. There are currently 253 beds across the four sites of QHC.
