### Department Head Critical Care The Faculty of Medicine, University of Ottawa and The Ottawa Hospital

The Ottawa Hospital (TOH) and the University of Ottawa invite applications for the position of Department Head Critical Care.

The Department of Critical Care at TOH includes two state-of-the-art 28 bed, multidisciplinary Intensive Care Units, one at each of the Civic and General campuses. Staffed by 17 Critical Care specialists from diverse backgrounds, the ICU of the Ottawa Hospital is the tertiary referral centre for critically ill patients from across the Champlain Local Health Integration Network (LHIN). There is capacity to expand the ICU within existing space to a total of 65 beds. The Department of Critical Care provides multidisciplinary, medical/surgical care, with the ICU at the Civic campus focusing on general medicine, trauma, neurosciences and vascular surgery patients, while the General campus ICU includes general medicine, with a focus on hematology/oncology, transplantation and thoracic surgery patients. In addition to its progressive clinical services, the Department of Critical Care offers a well-recognized and highly sought after Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons Critical Care fellowship training programme, as well

as an established and reputable clinical research programme with nationally-funded investigators. The Canadian Resuscitation institute and Educational network (CRI-EDUNET) originated from within the Department and together with our intensivists/educators has evolved into the premier Critical Care education resource in Canada, providing training including high fidelity simulation for a variety of healthcare professionals and remains a Departmental priority.
